Revelation 19:1-8 (KJV)

1. What did the dragon do when he was cast down to the earth?


 ¹² Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time. ¹³ And when the dragon saw that he was cast unto the earth, he persecuted the woman which brought forth the man *child*.
Revelation 12:12-13 (KJV)

2. Indicate the one who is being worshipped in each of the following Scriptures.


 ³ And I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and all the world wondered after the beast. ⁴ And they worshipped the dragon which gave power unto the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who *is* like unto the beast? who is able to make war with him?
Revelation 13:3-4 (KJV)

 ¹¹ And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon. ¹² And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed. **Revelation 13:11-12 (KJV)**


3. What happened to those who *would not* worship the image of the beast?

 And he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed. **Revelation 13:15 (KJV)**


4. What happened to those who would not receive the mark of the beast?

 ¹⁶ And he causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads: ¹⁷ And that no man might buy or sell, save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. **Revelation 13:16-17 (KJV)**


5. What is the mark of the beast?


 Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is Six hundred threescore *and* six. **Revelation 13:18 (KJV)**

6. What will happen to those who receive the mark of the beast?


 ⁹ And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive *his* mark in his forehead, or in his hand, ¹⁰ The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: **Revelation 14:9-10 (KJV)**


7. Why do you think the works of the saints follow them after physical death?

 And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them. **Revelation 14:13 (KJV)**

 And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever. **Revelation 15:7 (KJV)**


 Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God who lives forever and ever. **Revelation 15:7 (NKJV)**

9. Indicate what happened when each of the seven angels poured out their bowls (vials).


First Bowl _____

 And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image. **Revelation 16:2 (KJV)**


Second Bowl _____

 And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea. **Revelation 16:3 (KJV)**


Third Bowl

 And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood. **Revelation 16:4 (KJV)**


Fourth Bowl

 And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire. **Revelation 16:8 (KJV)**


Fifth Bowl

 ¹⁰ And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, ¹¹ And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds. **Revelation 16:10-11 (KJV)**

Sixth Bowl


 And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared. **Revelation 16:12 (KJV)**

Seventh Bowl


 ¹⁷ And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. ¹⁸ And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. **Revelation 16:17-18 (KJV)**
