Leaves Damascus and goes to **Arabia** (Galatians 1:17)
Leaves Arabia and returns to **Damascus** (Galatians 1:17)
Escape to **Jerusalem** (Acts 9:23-26)
Escape to **Caesarea** enroute to Tarsus (Acts 9:30)
Barnabus goes to **Tarsus** to bring **Paul** to **Antioch** of Syria (Acts 11:25)
Barnabas and **Paul** goes on the **first missionary journey** (Acts 13:2-3)
(John Mark was with Barnabas and Paul during a portion of this mission)
